5.1. COVID-19 policies and experiences at the elementary, middle school and high school levels. (Principal and teacher representatives from BLRA and BLPA)

Ranch (Voltz) = currently all virtual, teachers working hard to provide quality education, Molnar has plans to share cases in weekly Smore, will present several options to BOD for return to learn in Jan., overall, cohort system worked well,

MS/HS (Dahlman) = echoed Ranch report, wanting to report data out to families, shut down as a preemptive, but would've ended up shutting down anyways due to quarantined staff within a few days, D49 shared that Jan 15 (after MLK) is strategic return date due to people still traveling, will present variety of options to BOD (full in person, hybrid, percentage of MS in person, etc). Even though BOD meeting is tomorrow night, decision may be made about Dec 29th where communication is sent to families to ensure current numbers and needs of county and district, teachers have been persevering and adaptable to all circumstance. 2nd semester, students will have 4 periods a day – all day, split week

Staff retention with all going on – Secondary = 2 MOY resignations, Elem = 1 MOY resignation due to moving, but she will be operating K-2 online Schoology platform

SAC bring to BOD tomorrow night – need to clear communication, including in meeting minutes
