Students applying for the D49 Concurrent Enrollment must complete a CE Student Request Form, meet eligibility requirements, and have a meeting with your school counselor to discuss your academic plan. Application is open to students with no conduct issues, truancy issues, and a 2.5 GPA or higher.

SAT/PSAT (score of 470+), Accuplacer (score of 62+ 70+), EdReady (score of 90+), or AP/IB test scores must be attached.
