**Polos: Plain & solid in color.
Any color except NEON. NO LOGOS.**



Oxford button up shirts: Plain & solid in color. Any color except NEON. NO LOGOS.



NOT dress code compliant shirts: NEON, not solid, no collar, & logos.

**Appropriate Outerwear: Sweaters, sweater vests, cardigans, sweatshirts (including hoodies):
Plain & solid in color. Any color except NEON. NO LOGOS.**

School dress code shirt must be worn under outerwear.



NOT Dress Code Compliant Outerwear: Not plain, logos, pictures.



Girl pants, shorts, skirts: Plain and solid in color except neon.

Guy pants & shorts: Plain & solid in color except neon.

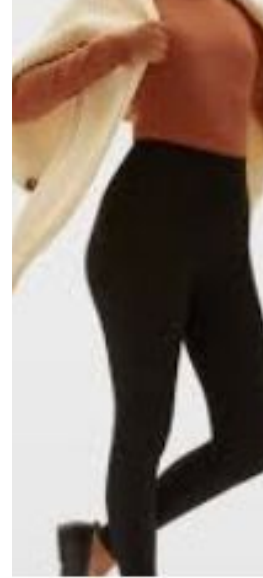

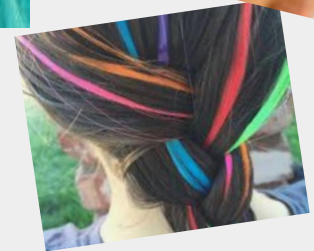
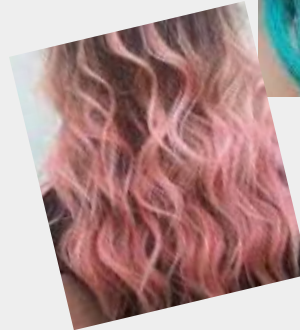

Dress Code Policy

Consequences for Non-Compliance

First and second offense – verbal warning, parent is notified, student gets into compliance, documented in PowerSchool via Log Entry.

Third and any future offenses – After school detention.
Consequences may escalate for repeated violations.

Free Dress Fridays!

On Fridays, students may have free dress as long as they adhere to the following rules:

- Top of chest to bottom of fingertips must be covered.
- No ripped jeans.
- No tank tops; shoulders must be covered.
- Clothing may not contain guns, profanity, drugs/alcohol of any sort, or offensive language.
- No hats.
- No pajamas.
